



### **List of documents for Fee Waiver Application**

Please see the list of documents you need to provide:

- Proof of Identity: Your passport, national identity card, or eVisa
- Proof of Financial Situation: Evidence to demonstrate you cannot afford the application fees and/or the Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS).
  - Six months of bank statements for all accounts.
  - Payslips from the last six months.
  - A letter from your employer confirming your employment.
  - Proof of household expenses, such as rent or utility bills.
  - Letters from local authorities or family members if you receive financial support from them.
  - Proof of any benefits you receive, such as a letter from DWP or your Universal Credit journal.

### **Key Requirements**

- Fee waivers are typically available for human rights applications.
- You must apply for a fee waiver no more than 28 days before your current leave to remain expires.
- You must submit the fee waiver application online and provide supporting documents within 10 working days.
- If your fee waiver is granted, you will receive a code and must apply for your visa within 28 days of the decision

### **Other important requirements**

- Evidence of any health issues you or your dependants have.
- Your tenancy agreement or mortgage bills.
