



List of documents for Indefinite Leave to Remain as a Bereaved Partner

Please see the list of documents you need to provide:

- Proof of Identity: A valid passport or other document that shows your identity and nationality.
- Proof of your Partner's Death: An official death certificate of your partner.
- Proof of Relationship: Evidence that your relationship was genuine and subsisting immediately before your partner's death. This can include a marriage or civil partnership certificate, joint bank statements, utility bills, or a tenancy agreement.
- Proof of Immigration Status: Your biometric residence permit (BRP) or other proof of your last grant of leave as a partner.

Other Important Requirements

- The bereaved partner route is specifically for individuals whose last grant of leave was as a partner of a British citizen or settled person.
- You can apply for Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR) at any time after your partner's death.
- You must be physically present in the UK to apply.
- You do not need to take the English language test or the Life in the UK test.
- You must have been living with your partner in the UK and have intended to live together permanently in the UK.
