



List of documents for Parent of a Child Visa

Please see the list of documents you need to provide:

- Child's birth certificate: To prove the relationship between you and your child.
- Your passport and immigration status.
- Proof of address: This could include a tenancy agreement, property inspection report, or utility bills to show you have adequate accommodation.
- Proof of your financial stability: You must prove you can support yourself and your child without relying on public funds. This can be shown with bank statements, payslips, or third-party support. There is no strict income threshold for this visa.
- Proof of parenting responsibility: You must be able to prove that you're taking an active role in your child's upbringing. Evidence can include court-mandated custody, communication logs, photos, and letters from the child's school confirming your involvement.

Other Important Requirements

- Your child must be under 18 and a British citizen or have settled status in the UK.
- You must not be living with the child's other parent as a partner.
- You must meet the English language requirement by passing an approved test, having a degree taught in English, or being from an English-speaking country.
- The visa is typically granted for 2.5 years and can be extended. After five years of continuous residence, you may qualify for Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR).
