List of documents for Proposed Civil Partner Visa

Please see the list of documents you need to provide:

- Proof of Identity: A valid passport for both you and your partner.
- Proof of Relationship: Evidence that you have met each other. You must prove that any
 previous marriages or civil partnerships have ended. You will also need to show
 evidence of your ongoing commitment to each other, such as shared financial
 documents, joint bank statements, or proof of cohabitation.
- Proof of Financial Status: You must meet the financial requirements. The minimum annual income threshold is at least £29,000. You can also meet this with cash savings over £16,000 or non-work income.
- Proof of Accommodation: Evidence that you have adequate accommodation to live in with your partner without recourse to public funds.
- Proof of English Language: You must meet the English language requirement.

Other Important Requirements

- Both you and your partner must be at least 18 years old.
- You must have the intention to live together in the UK.
- You must be free to marry or register a civil partnership.
- You will be granted a 6 month visa to enter the UK and get married or enter into a civil partnership. You will not be able to work or study during this time.
- After registering your civil partnership, you must apply to extend your stay in the UK.
