



List of documents for UK Ancestry Visa

Please see the list of documents you need to provide:

- Proof of Identity: You must provide a valid passport.
 - Proof of Ancestry: You must prove that one of your grandparents was born in the UK, the Channel Islands, the Isle of Man, or before 31 March 1922 in what is now the Republic of Ireland. You must also provide a birth certificate or adoption papers to prove this relationship.
 - Proof of Financial Status: You must have enough money to support and house yourself and any dependants without needing help from public funds.
 - Tuberculosis (TB) Test Certificate: This is required in some cases.

Other Important Requirements

- You must be 17 or older to apply.
 - You can and plan to work in the UK.
 - The visa allows you to work, study, and bring your partner or children with you.
 - The visa can lead to Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR) after five years of continuous residence in the UK.
 - If you apply for ILR, you may need to pass the Life in the UK Test.
 - You should get a decision on your visa within three weeks if you apply from outside the UK.
