List of documents for Civil Partner Visa UK

Please see the list of documents you need to provide:

- Proof of Identity: A valid passport for both you and your partner.
- Proof of Relationship: Evidence that you are in a legally recognized civil partnership.
 Your civil partnership must be evidenced by an official certificate. You must also prove
 that you have met your partner in person at least once and that any previous
 relationship has permanently ended. Evidence of a genuine and long-term relationship,
 such as shared financial responsibilities, regular contact, or proof of living together, is
 also required.
- Proof of Financial Status: You must meet the financial requirements. The minimum annual income threshold is at least £29,000.
- Proof of Accommodation: Evidence that you have adequate accommodation to live in with your partner.
- Proof of English Language: You must meet the English language requirement.

Other Important Requirements

- Both you and your partner must be at least 18 years old.
- You must intend to live together permanently in the UK.
- The visa allows you to live and work in the UK.
- The visa can lead to Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR) after a five-year period.
- The visa is granted on a 30 month basis and can be extended for a further 30 months.
