



List of documents for Scale-up Worker Visa UK

Please see the list of documents you need to provide:

- Valid Passport: A current passport or other document that shows your identity and nationality.
- Certificate of Sponsorship (CoS) reference number: This is a unique number your employer will give you.
- Proof of English Language: Evidence that you can speak, read, write, and understand English at a minimum of CEFR level B1. This can be met by passing an approved English language test, holding a degree taught in English, or being a national of a majority English-speaking country.
- Tuberculosis (TB) Test Certificate: Required if you are from a country where you need to take a TB test.
- Proof of Relationship: Evidence such as a marriage or civil partnership certificate, or birth certificate for any family members applying as dependants.

Other Important Requirements

- You must be at least 18 years old.
- You must have a confirmed job offer from an approved scale-up business for at least 6 months.
- The visa is initially granted for two years, and you are tied to your sponsoring employer for the first six months. After that, you are free to change jobs, work for other employers, or become self-employed.
- The visa can lead to Indefinite Leave to Remain (ILR) after five years.
